2023 Summer Water Polo Club Fees

Athletes, Regardless Of School District, Will Pay Same Fees In Each Respective Age Group

Athletes entering 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and college. Season Pass*	\$ 300.00
Athletes entering 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and college. Single Day Pass	\$ 25.00
Athletes entering 5th grade through 8th grade. Season Pass*	\$ 200.00
Athletes entering 5th grade through 8th grade. Single Day Pass	\$ 15.00

*Includes all camp days

Any family with more than one participant will receive \$ 20.00 off the cost of each additional member after the first (high school level only).

Every athlete must pay the summer water polo fee to participate.

Third Coast Aquatics JO Qualifier & Great Lakes Classic Tournament Fees

All club team pricing is approximate for the 2023 season

In order for our team to qualify to play in the Junior Olympic Tournament in Texas this summer, we may have to compete in a qualifier tournament.

\$ 130.00 - Player fee to participate in the qualifier - Register by May 15

\$ 90.00 - Great Lakes Classic Fees (East Kentwood High School)

*All Junior Olympic athletes must register for a gold membership at www.usawaterpolo.org.

There is a one time age verification fee of \$ 5.00.

The hotel and travel cost are additional.

All Junior Olympic players must receive permission from the coach in order to miss this tournament.

Junior Olympic (Orange County) Tournament Water Polo Team Fees

FAQ's

Does an athlete need to be a Gold Member to play in J.O.'s or the qualifier?

Yes. These are both USA Water Polo sanctioned events. They need to pay the \$ 140.00 Fee and assign Third Coast Aquatics as their club. The Great Lakes Classic is sanctioned this year as well.

Can an athlete participate in the qualifier or any other summer tournament's if they are not planning on participating in J.O.'s?

Yes. With coach approval they can. They would need to pay any tournament player fees and be a gold member if necessary.

Can I be a J.O. Team member if I miss the qualifier or any of the other summer tournaments?

It is heavily recommended that if you are playing in J.O.'s you participate in all the summer tournaments. Exceptions can only be made by the head coach.

Can anybody sign up for Junior Olympic portion of the program?

No. The team is selected by the coaches at their discretion.

Does an athlete have to stay in the athlete room?

No. An athlete may stay in his parents room.

Are meals included?

No. All athletes must bring money for their own meals. We will attempt to book a hotel with free breakfast.
